HSPE INFORMATION

The High School Proficiency Exam is this week! The Reading test is Tuesday March 16 and the Writing test is Wednesday March 17 and Thursday March 18. All 10th grade students and any juniors and seniors who have not previously passed WASL in these subject areas must attend testing on these days. Failure to attend will jeopardize your student's ability to meet state graduation requirements. If your student is a senior, he or she will **not** graduate this June if he or she fails to take the sections of the HSPE he or she has not passed. Testing begins promptly at **8:00am** and runs to 11:00am each of the days listed above. All students must be on time. There are **NO** make-ups if a student misses a test day!! Please make sure your student has plenty of rest and eats a good breakfast each day. Students should also bring a snack and a silent reading book in case they finish early.
